II. Call for Steering Group members of the “Forum on Publishing and Research Assessment”

The International Science Council (ISC) has launched a new project “*ISC Forum on Publishing and Research Assessment*” to address current challenges in scientific publishing and research assessment. The project will build on the success of the Future of Scientific Publishing project and the ISC’s previous work on research assessment.

To guide and support the project, the ISC is establishing a Steering Group, which will provide strategic oversight to the project, contribute to project outputs, support project promotion and dissemination, and advise on stakeholder engagement.

Steering Group members will be appointed from July 2025 to December 2026 and are expected to meet approximately four times per year, primarily virtually, with occasional in-person meetings aligned with major milestones or events.
